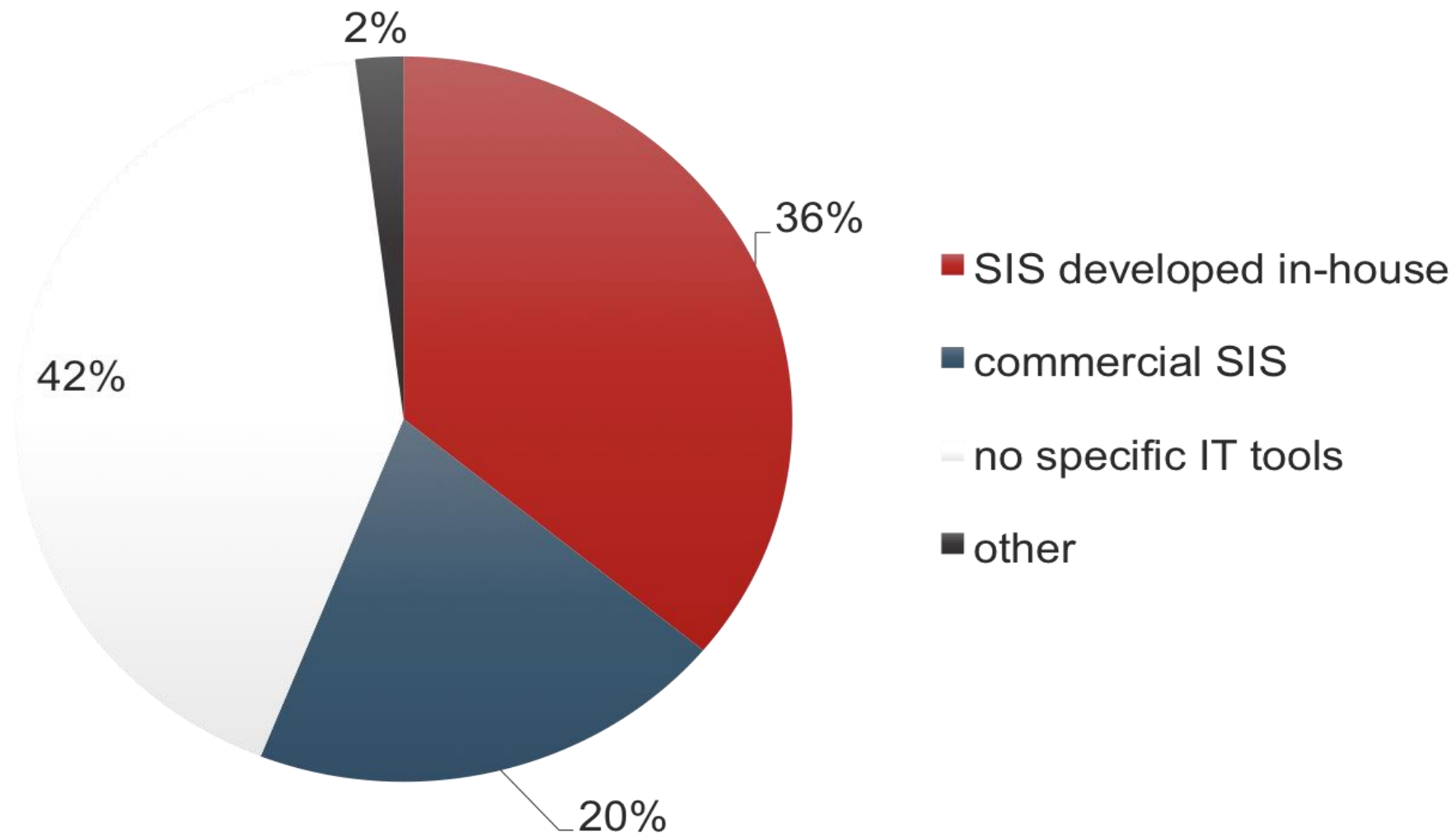

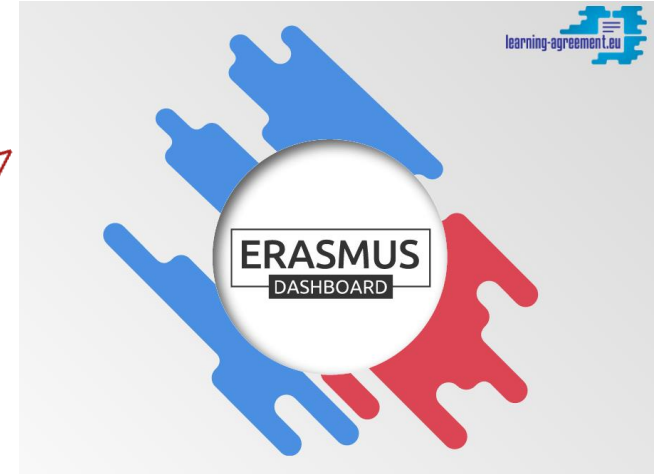

- Dialogue with other stakeholders about responsibility beyond the project lifespan

Risk assessment

- High level of trust is needed!
- Institutions exchange data with partners of their choice!

Potential problems

- Bad quality of APIs
- Low server availability
- Providing incomplete/inconsistent data
- Not trustworthy partner

→ Competence center can decide to temporarily recall the access to the production registry
